



ICAS at home Preparation Checklist for Parents and Students

This preparation checklist will guide you through preparing for your child to sit ICAS at home under the school’s remote supervision. Please read and follow the steps carefully.

Your child’s teacher will set the date and time for your child to sit the ICAS test.

BEFORE TEST DAY CHECKLIST (TIME FRAMES AT DISCRETION OF TEACHER)	EXTRA RESOURCES
 UP TO 14 DAYS BEFORE TEST DAY	
Your child’s teacher will contact you about your child using ICAS from home.	
If your child’s device is compatible, download Google Chrome internet browser. This is the most compatible internet browser to use with ICAS Mathematics, English, Science and Digital Technologies.	Read the Technical requirements for devices and browsers compatible with ICAS
If your child is sitting ICAS Writing or Spelling Bee, install Janison Replay onto your child’s device (and onto a spare device, if possible).	Read about and install Janison Replay
Your child’s teacher will send you your child’s one-time code(s) . Write these down and keep handy. These are used to access the test.	
Read the exam conditions and prepare an area for your child to sit their ICAS test.	Read exam conditions
 ON TEST DAY	
Your child’s teacher will send you your child’s session code . This must be used along with the subject-specific one-time code to enter the ICAS test. Write these codes down. Session code is entered first.	
Your child’s teacher will run the test with your child. Please ensure your child follows the exam conditions.	Read exam conditions

Once your child has successfully submitted their test, there is nothing further to do.
