

ICAS at home Checklist for Schools

This preparation checklist will guide you through running ICAS whilst your students are learning from home. Please read and follow the steps carefully.

Some steps in this checklist can only be completed by your school's staff member who holds the Assessment Portal School Coordinator account.

Before you start: Set the date and time that you would like your students to sit their ICAS test (see [Assessment Calendar](#) for sitting window).

 1 Hour before test commences	
Applies to ICAS Mathematics, Science, English and Digital Technologies only: students enter icas.site/start into their internet browser. Alternatively, send your students the Assessments Portal QR code to scan to get access to the Assessments Portal.	icas.site/start is the URL for the Assessments Portal Download the Assessments Portal QR code
From the Assessments Portal, create the session code. Note: Session codes can only be created on the day of the test. They expire at midnight on the day of creation.	Watch the video tutorial on Supervise a Live Test.
Just before test commencement, video call your students and read out the script found in the Test Supervision Instructions. Provide the session code to all the students. Check they have their one-time code ready.	Read the section on the applicable ICAS subject found in the Test Supervision Instructions. Visit the ICAS Support page.
Important note: The Janison Replay app, used for Writing and Spelling Bee, will force shutdown the video call. Ensure students have their session code and one-time code on hand prior to students opening the app on their device.	

<p>Wait for all the students to have successfully input the session code and one-time code.</p> <p>From your Supervise Live Test screen on the Assessments Portal, now start the session.</p> <p>Note: Any students who input the session and one-time code after you click "Start Session", will have to be manually given entry.</p>	<p>Watch the video tutorial on Supervise a Live Test.-</p> <p>On Supervise Live Test screen, click the tab "Waiting Entry", select the checkbox next to the student's name then click the button Allow Entry.</p>

When the results are ready to view online, your school will be notified by an email from ICAS Assessments. Your school will also receive hardcopy ICAS certificates and results via post for each student. It is at your school's discretion to distribute certificates to the students and/or parents.

Please note, however, that parents will obtain access to their child's results online by using their Results Portal login credentials found on the back of their child's ICAS certificate.

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
