



## ICAS at home Checklist for Schools

This preparation checklist will guide you through running ICAS whilst your students are learning from home. Please read and follow the steps carefully.

Some steps in this checklist can only be completed by your school's staff member who holds the Assessment Portal School Coordinator account.

**Before you start:** Set the date and time that you would like your students to sit their ICAS test (see <u>Assessment Calendar</u> for sitting window).

From the Assessments Portal, create the session code. Note: Session codes can only be created on the day of the test. They expire at midnight on the day of creation.	Watch the video tutorial on <u>Supervise a Live Test</u>
