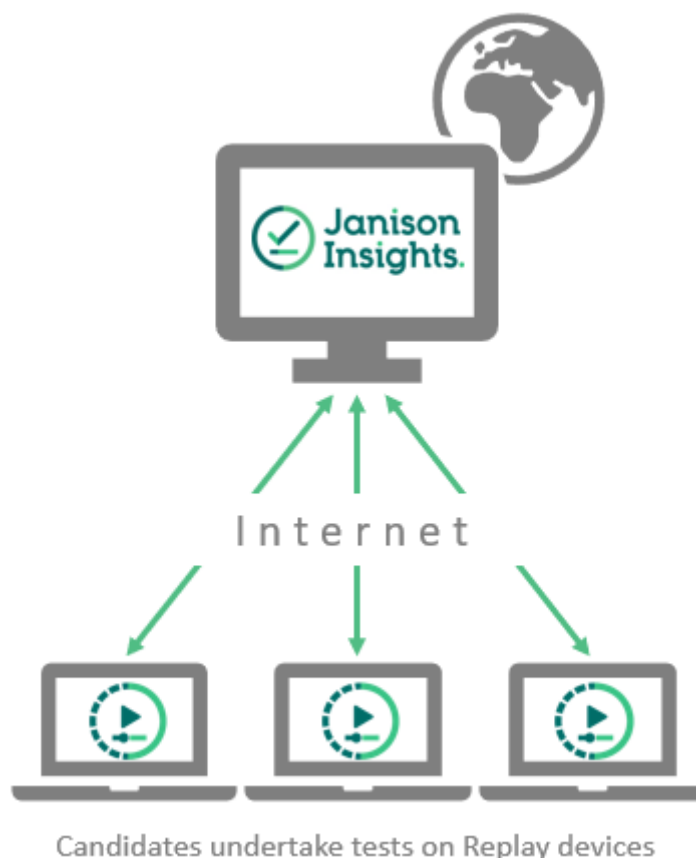

1. Introduction

Janison Replay (Replay) is a digital test delivery application that allows students to participate in the ICAS and Reach online assessments. Replay locks the device down so that the student can't access anything on their device outside of the app during the test.



1.1 System requirements for Replay installation

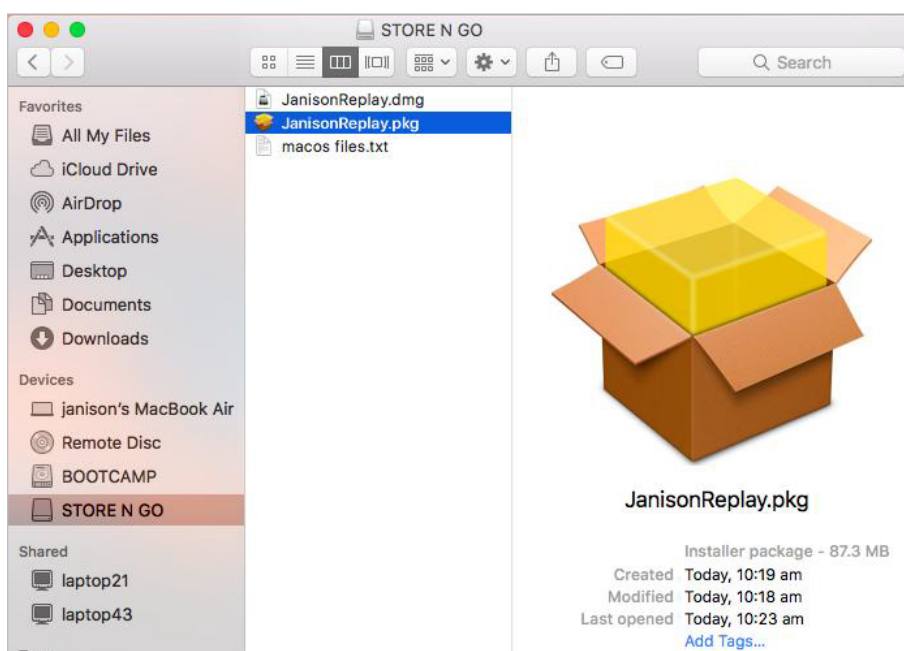
2. Installation

Technical specialists will need to install a copy of the app on each of the student devices.

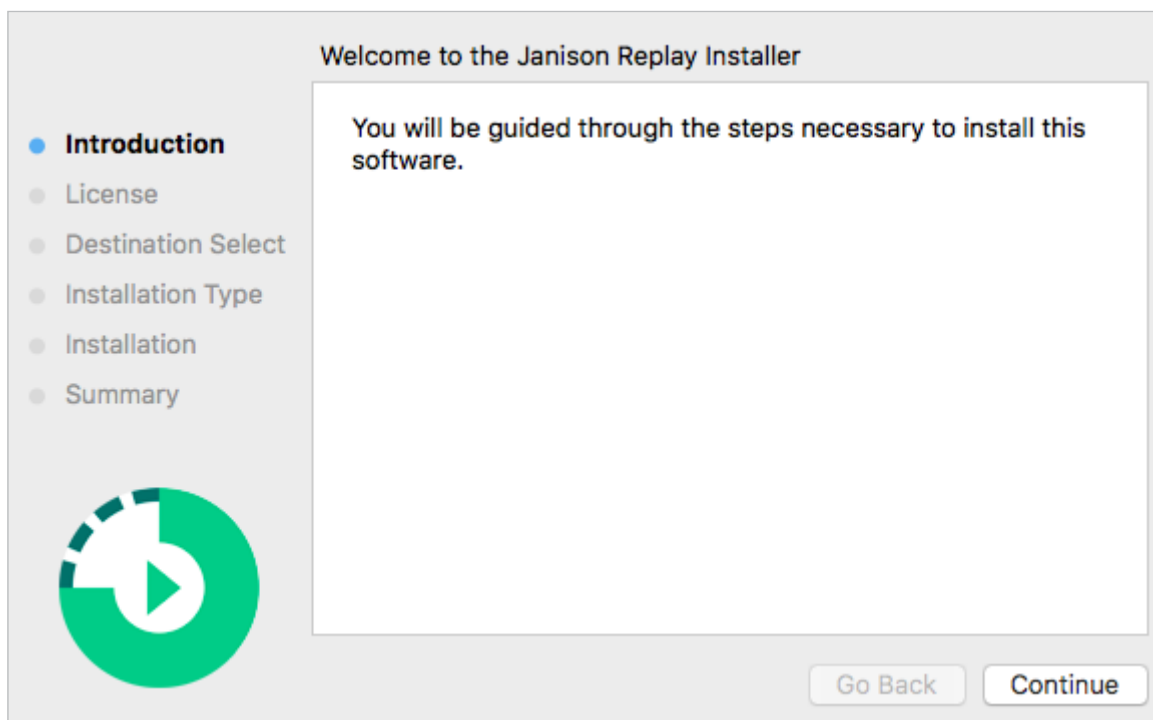
⚠ Important: Please ensure that you have uninstalled any previous Janison replay applications on your macbook

2.1 Install Replay

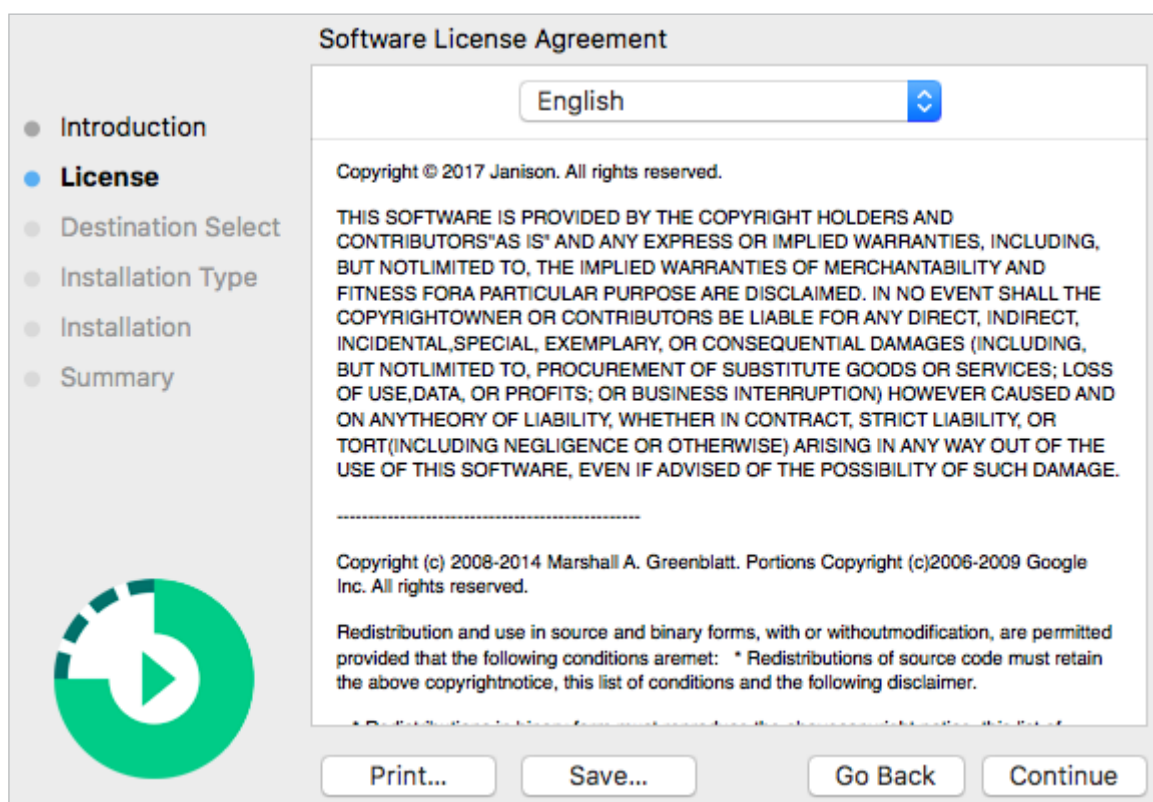
Download the install file Janison Replay v5.12.0.pkg or Janison Replay 5.12.0.dmg and place a copy on the student device. You install the app as you do with any other app.



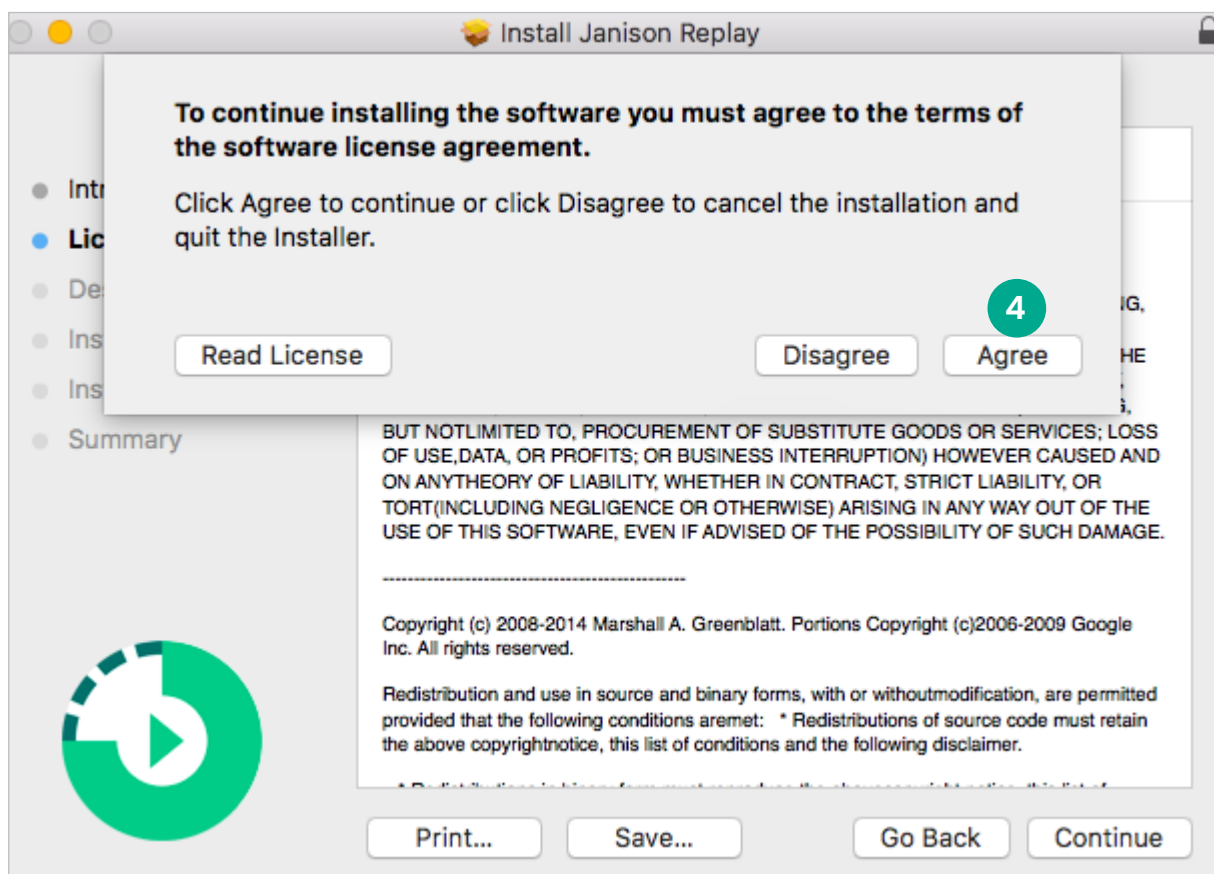
1. Select the install file.



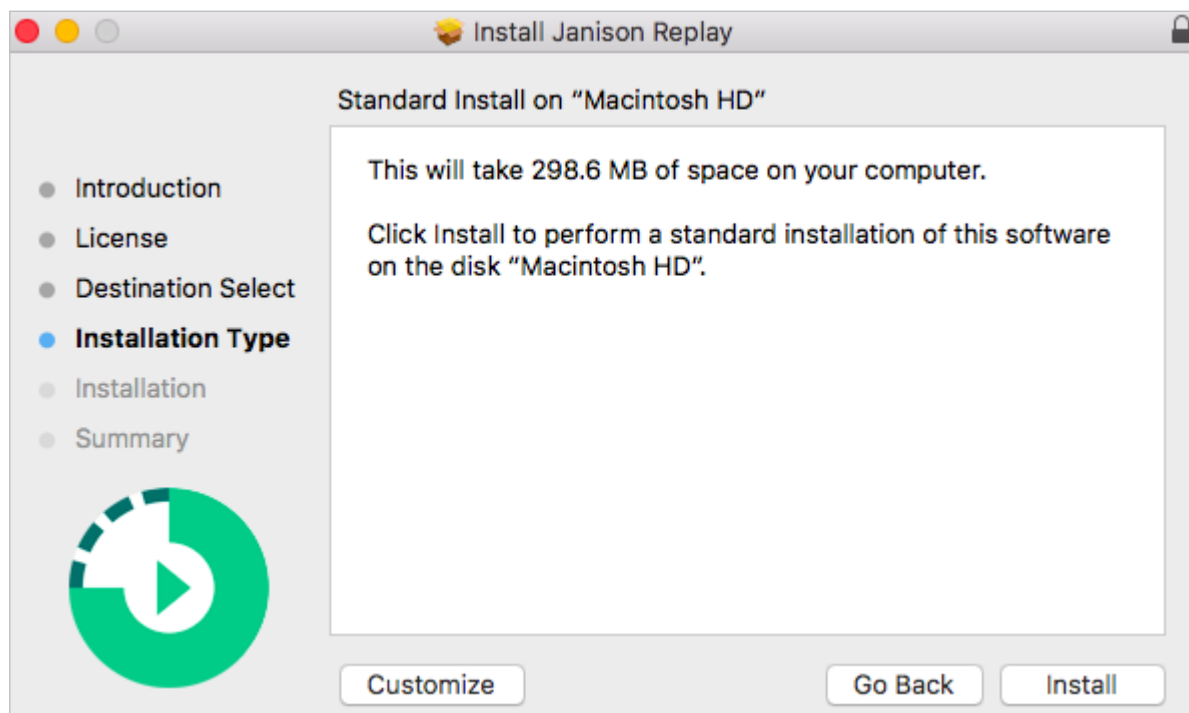
2. Select **Continue**.



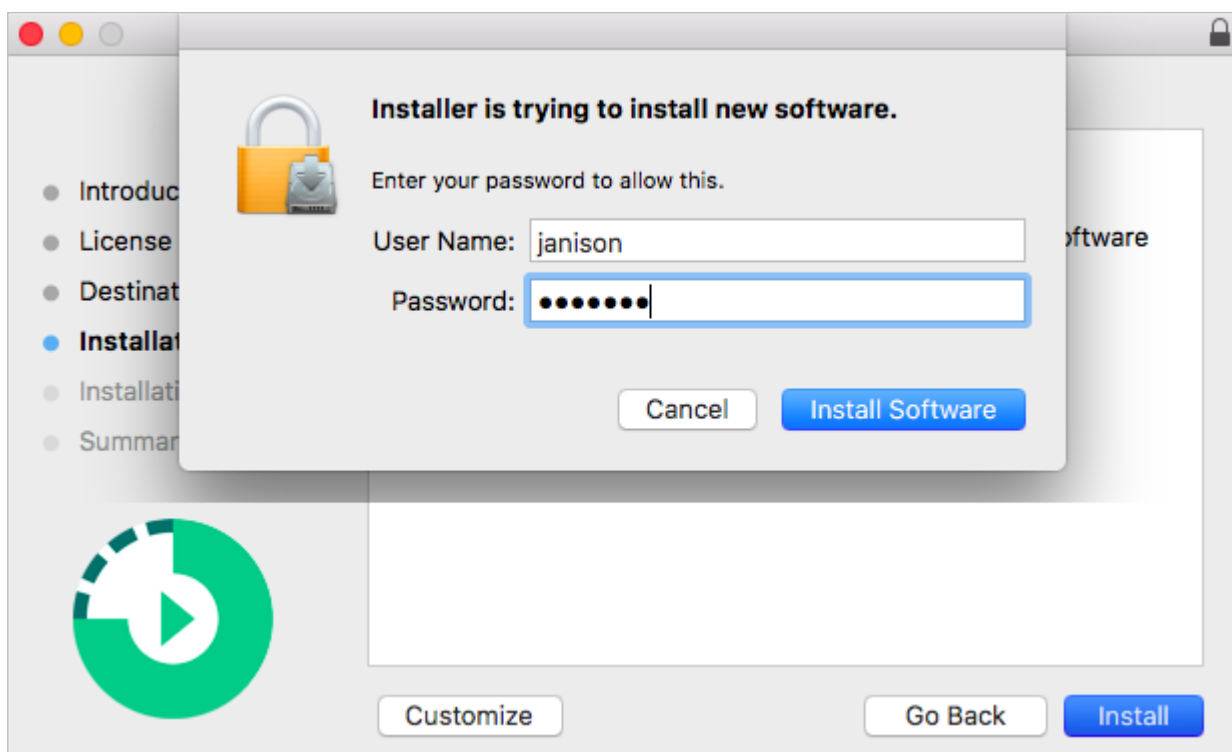
3. Select **Continue**.



4. If you agree with the terms, select **Agree**.
5. Select **Continue**.



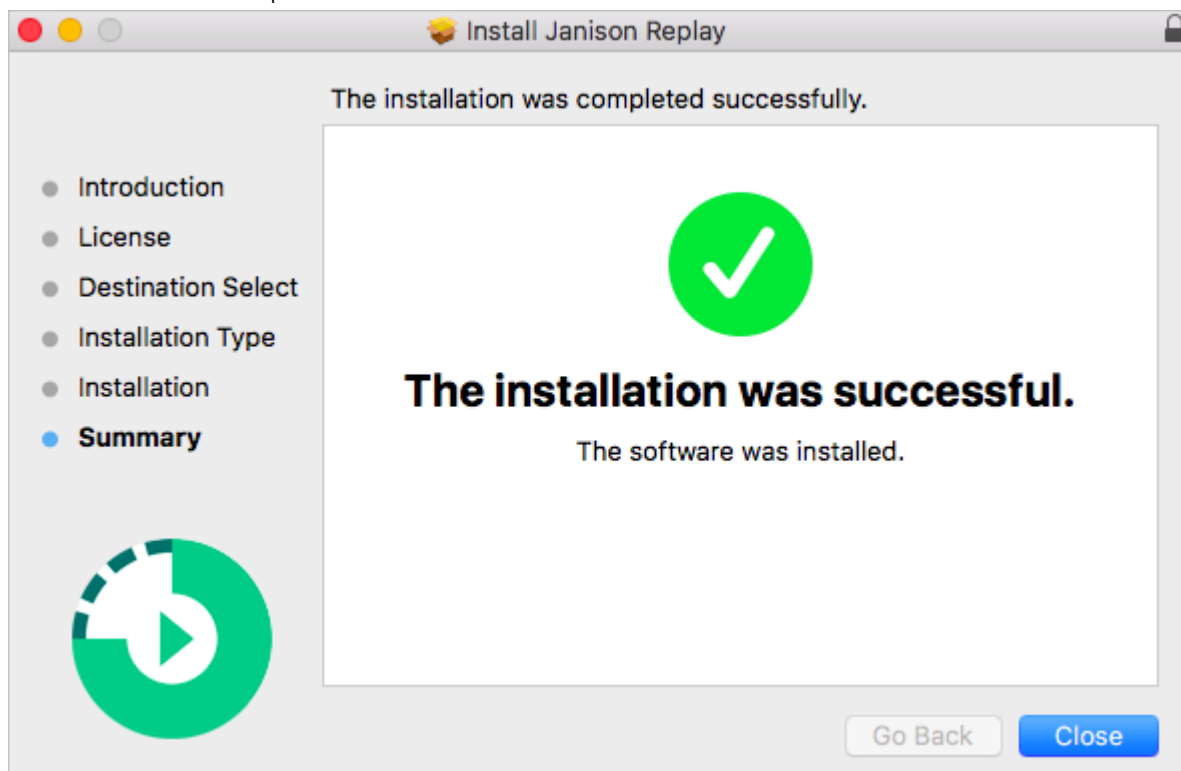
6. Select **Install**.



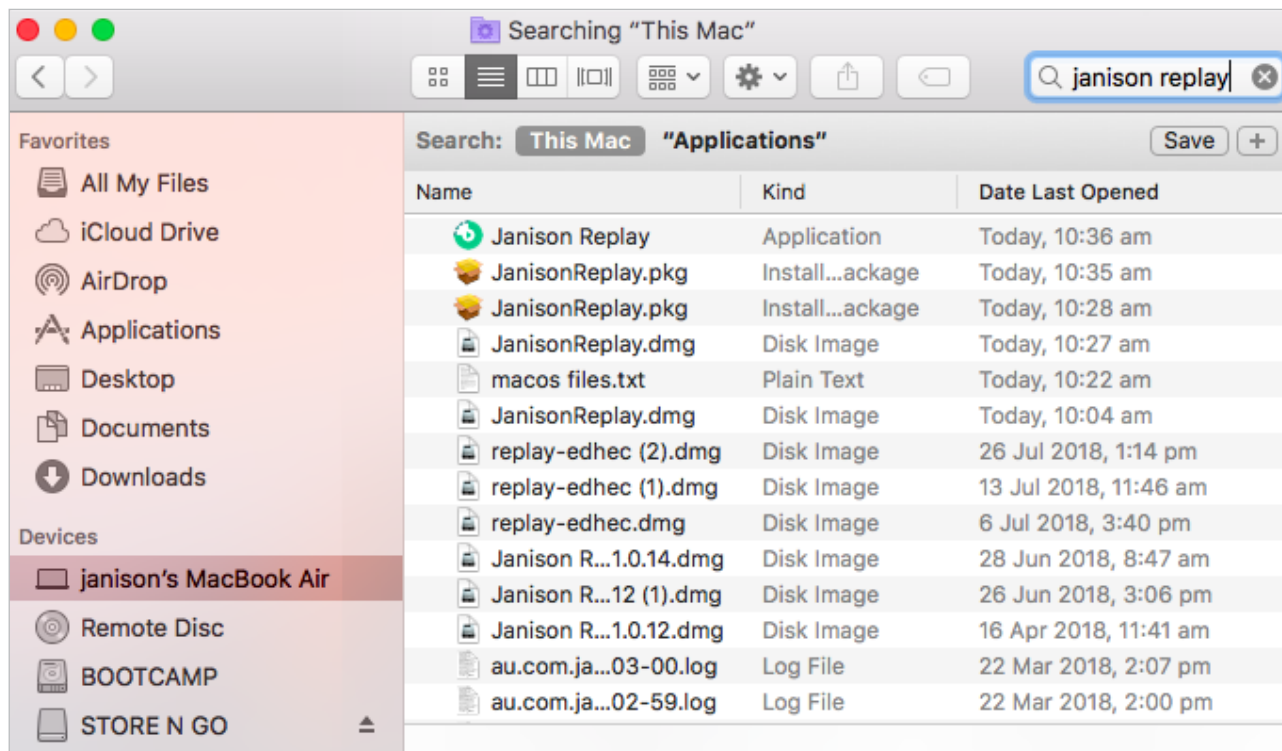
7. Enter your device **User Name** and **Password**.

8. Select **Install Software**.

The installation completes.



9. Select **Close**.



10. Replay can now be launched.

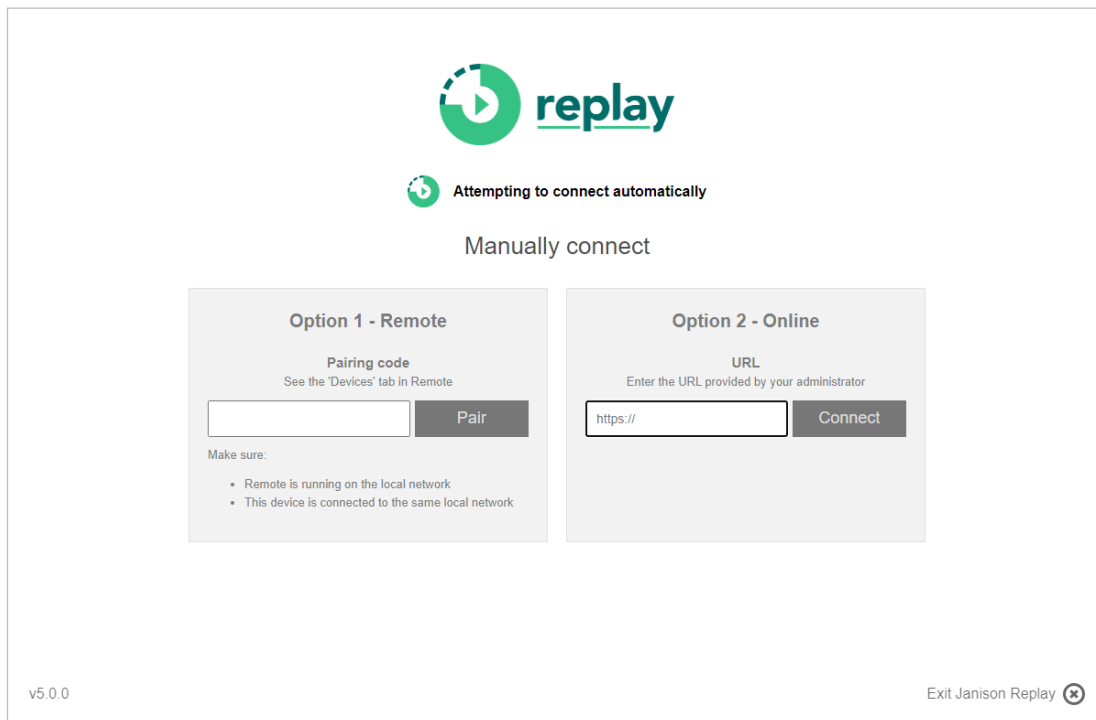
2.2 Entering ICAS/REACH Assessments URL is automatic now

After **Replay** is launched for the first time, it should automatically redirect you to the **ICAS Assessment platform** to start the Test. If this happens, **skip the steps below** and proceed directly to **Section 10**.

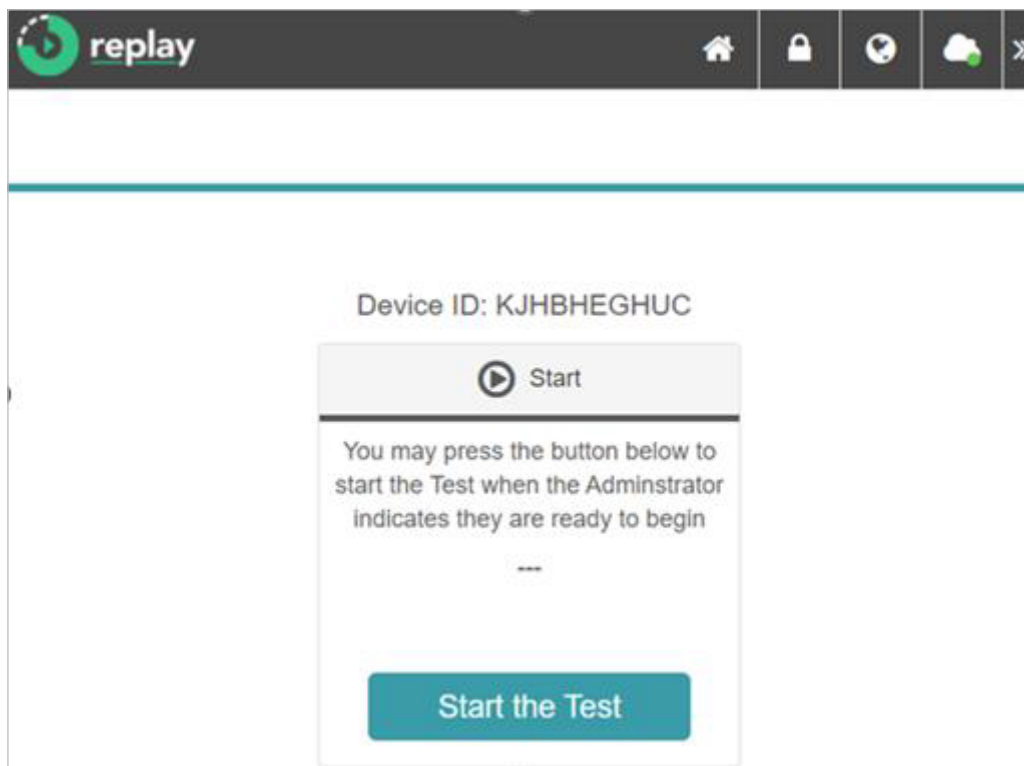
If you are not **automatically redirected** and instead see the screen shown below, follow these steps:

1. Select **Option 2 – Enter URL**
2. Enter: icasassessments.janisoninsights.com
3. Select **Connect**.

Note: This step is only required once, immediately after the initial installation.

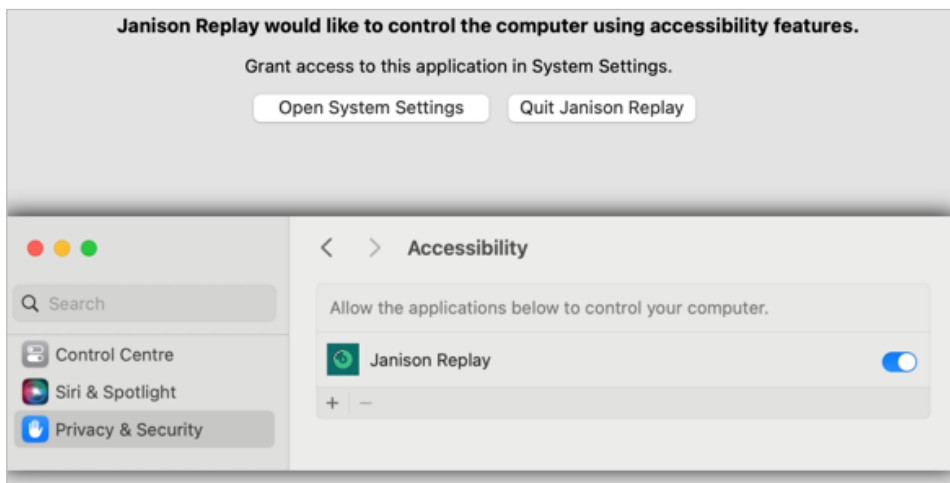


11. You should see the screen below.

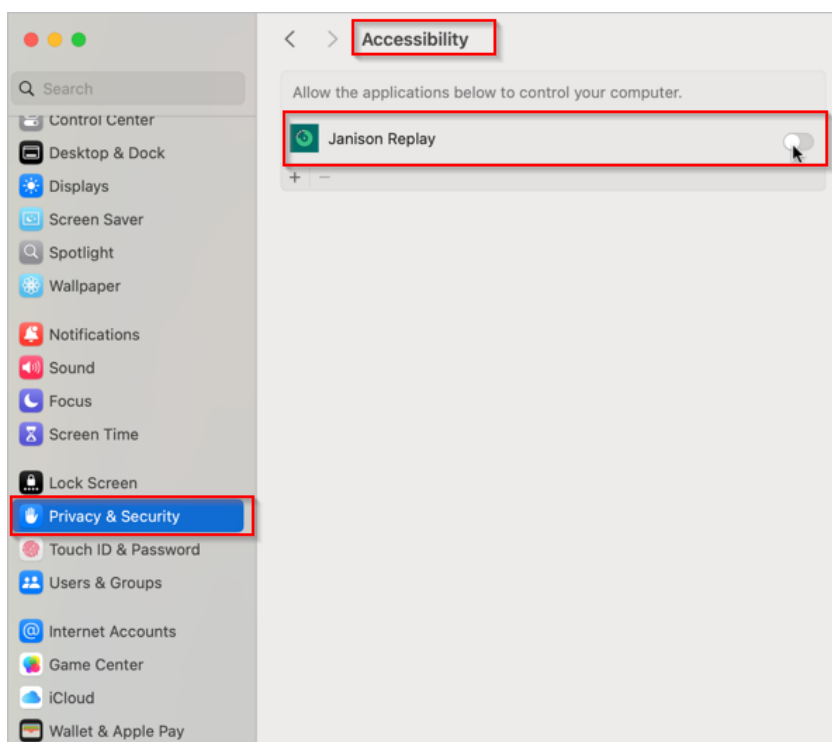


3. Janison Replay requires accessibility

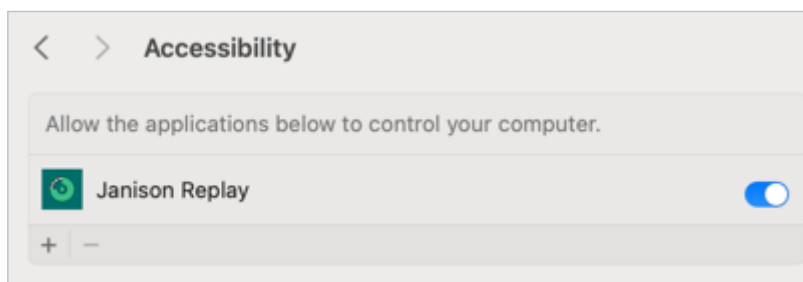
In most cases, this happens automatically during the first launch, but at times, Janison Replay might ask for accessibility to be provided manually. This means that you must grant accessibility to Janison Replay.



Only an administrator of the device can do this.
In order to do so, follow the below steps.



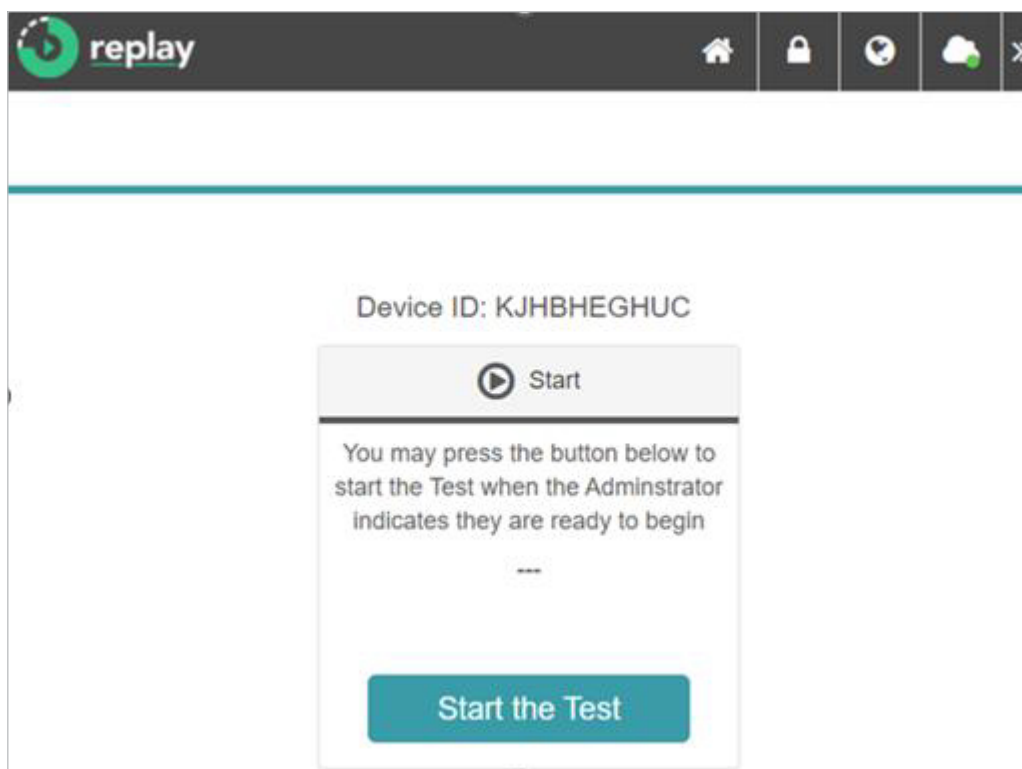
Go to MacOS **System Settings** → **Privacy & Security** → **Accessibility** → Toggle Janison Replay **ON**




Janison Replay can be launched now.

4. The student experience

On the day of the test, launch Replay on each of the student devices.




The student will select **Start the Test**.
